



Our shelters are open **24 hours a day, 365 days a year.**



City Union Mission is one of the largest Rescue Missions, out of 300, in the United States.



We do not receive government funding; we rely completely on support from individuals, businesses, foundations, organizations and churches.



In 2020, we **provided 108,227 beds for the homeless** – on average, 296 nightly.



We provide approximately **75% of the emergency shelter beds for the homeless in Kansas City** and the surrounding area.



We **provided 218,140 meals to the hungry** – nearly 600 each day!



City Union Mission is the **only shelter in Kansas City with infirmary beds** for those ill or injured.



City Union Mission **operates the Hotline for the Homeless— (816) 474-4599**, which provides information on available individual and family bed space.



We help prevent homelessness through **community assistance** – such as, assisting with utility bills, furniture, school uniforms, clothing, food and holidays—Thanksgiving and Mission Christmas.



Our **Learning Centers** offer opportunities to build resumes, obtain GEDs, prepare for the SAT, tutoring and more.



At the Vanderberg Youth Center, **after-school programs** for low-income youth are offered, which include tutoring and life skills classes.



Camp CUMCITO is a **summer camp** in the Ozarks for up to 650 low-income youth. Including, we offer a multi-week City Camp for youth, with more than 150 participating over the course of the summer.



In 2020, **392 people committed their lives to Christ** at City Union Mission.



Vocational training is offered at **The Harbor** facility in Warsaw, MO, giving hands-on baseline training towards skilled and professional trades.
